

### Finish Line

The finish line will be between the Committee Boat and the same white buoy and flag used at the start. The white buoy and flag will not be moved.

### Courses

Each crew will be given a chart with buoys numbered on it. (Keep the chart with you when you change boats.) The buoys to be rounded will be indicated by numbers displayed on the Committee Boat. For the order in which they must be rounded, read from the top down. The letter S displayed ahead of the buoy numbers indicates leave all marks to Starboard. The letter P indicates leave all marks to Port.

### Starting Sequence

	Fog Horn	
30 seconds later	Warning Gun	White Flag
5 minutes later	Preparatory Gun	Flag P
5 minutes later	Starting Gun	Flag S

### Mark Boat

A mark boat, flying a large white flag, will proceed around the course from buoy to buoy directly ahead of the leading boats.

### Spectator Boats

Spectator boats are invited to follow the races, but they are urged to keep clear and preferably to leeward of the competing yachts. They should operate at sufficiently reduced speed so as not to disturb the racing yachts with their wakes.
